DESCRIPTION OF BUILDING PRODUCT

JSC supplies a variety of hardwood decking timber species. They are supplied in standard or customised profiles. Standard options include,

- 90 x 19 mm,
- 115 x 19 mm,
- 140 x 33 mm, and
- 140 x 42 mm.

Species offered are:

- Tali (Erythrophleum ivorense). Durability class 1.
- Vitex (Vitex cofassus). Durability class 2.
- Purpleheart also known as Amarante (Peltogyne spp.). Durability class 1.
- Garapa (Apuleia leiocarpa). Durability class 2.
- Cumaru (Dipteryx oderata). Durability class 1.
- Spotted Gum (Corymbia maculata). Durability class 1.
- Iroko (Milicia excelsa. Durability class 1.
- Blackbutt (Eucalyptus pilularis). Durability class 1.
- Ironbark (Eucalyptus paniculata). Durability class 1.
- Ipe (Handoanthus spp). Durability class 1.
- Guariuba (Clarisia Racemosa). Durability class 1.



All have sufficient natural durability (class 1 or 2) meaning that they do not require chemical treatment to meet durability provisions.

The hardwood species supplied have at least the same modulus of rupture and elasticity and may therefore be used as a direct substitute for decking as provided for in NZS 3604:2011.

JSC has tested Garapa and Cumaru for slip resistance to AS/NZS 4586.2004, Appendix A. Results were as follows:

- Cumaru 41
- Garapa 44

JSC is the trading name of J Scott & Company.
