

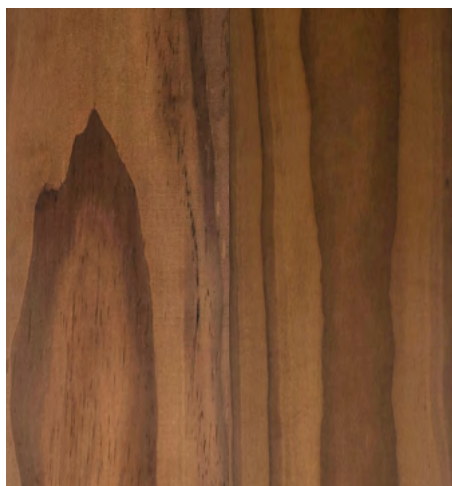

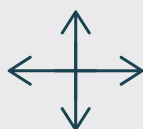

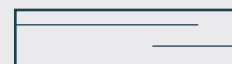

That means greater dimensional stability, a lower chance of movement, and a warm, rich colour that holds up beautifully over time. All done in a controlled environment, with no nasties released into your space.

What makes ThermoPine different?

Unlike many engineered or laminated alternatives, ThermoPine® uses single-piece, solid timber profiles - no glues, no layers, no bonding. Just timber, the way it should be. The boards are dimensionally stable yet rich with life – offering warm colour, tonal depth, and unique visual variation from board to board. It's this character that makes ThermoPine® so effective in modern interiors. Honest, high-performing timber with variation you can actually design with.

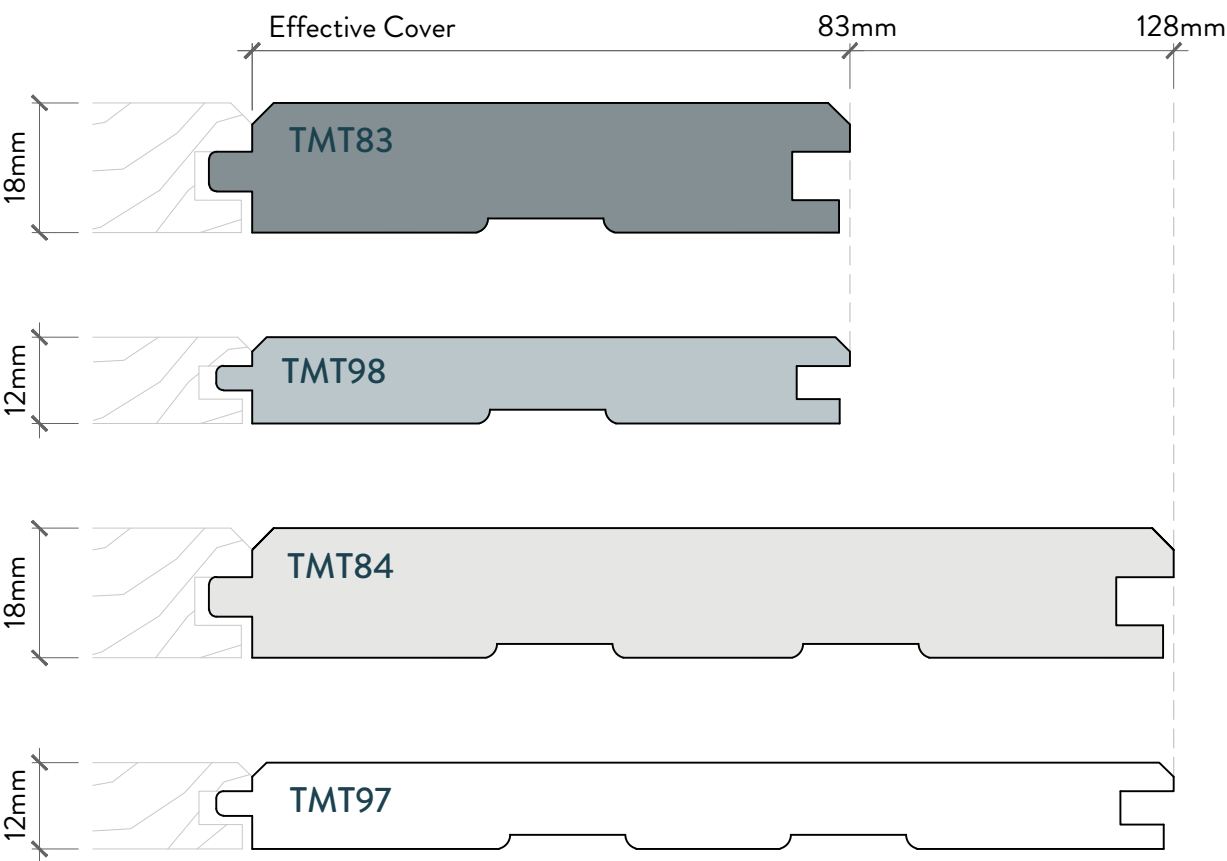

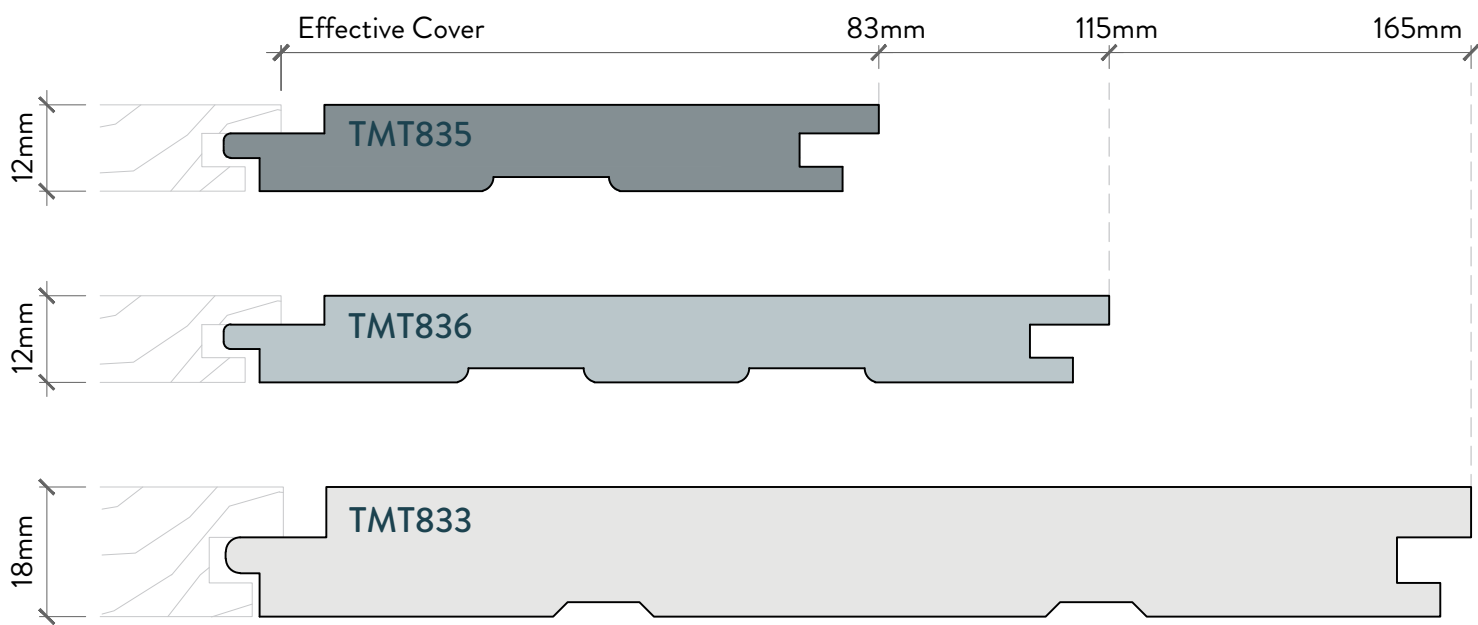
